## Sign up for emergency preparedness workshop

**August 28, 2014** – Do you want to know what to do the next time a natural or man-made disaster strikes? Sign up now for the free Preparedness Day Workshop that Hampton's Emergency Management Office will host Saturday, Sept. 27.

The workshop will focus on how to prepare for and safely live through disasters and other emergencies, including hurricanes, floods, tornadoes, blizzards and earthquakes.

Participants will rotate among six different stations, learning new information and skills about:

- Food and water safety
- Home safety
- First aid and hygiene
- Fraud and home security, including identity protection
- Planning documents
- Ready kits
