

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### **ON A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON, VIRGINIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE DESIGNATION OF AN ENTERPRISE ZONE PURSUANT TO THE VIRGINIA ENTERPRISE ZONE ACT.**

The City of Hampton is proposing to submit an application to designate a portion of the city as an Enterprise Zone. The goal of the Virginia Enterprise Zone Program is to promote economic development through job creation and real property investment by businesses located within a designated Enterprise Zone. There will be a public hearing to hear comments on the proposal on **Wednesday, June, 10, 2015 at 6:30 p.m.** in the Council Chambers, Eighth Floor, City Hall, 22 Lincoln Street, Hampton, Virginia 23669 to consider the following:

The designation of the Hampton Roads Center Enterprise Zone consists of 2,166.6 acres and is primarily located in the northeast quadrant of the city. The zone boundaries encompass Hampton Roads Center Central, North and South campuses, Langley Research and Development Park, Wythe Creek Industrial Park, WestPark and areas along Magruder Boulevard and Commander Shepard Boulevard, and a portion of the Coliseum Central area.
