Bluebird Gap one of top 10 petting zoos in nation

Oct. 14, 2016 - Hampton's Bluebird Gap Farm has been named one of the best petting zoos in the country by AmericanTowns Media, a technology and media content company in Westport, Conn.

Located on 60 acres in the heart of Hampton, Bluebird Gap Farm has around 150 domestic and wild animals, including horses, cows, whitetail deer, llamas, peacocks, rabbits and waterfowl. It features a covered pavilion with 18 picnic tables and a large charcoal grill. Other picnic tables and grills are located throughout the farm.

Snack and drink vending machines are located in the antique barn. And animal feed machines can be found throughout the farm for those wanting a more 'interactive' experience (don't forget your quarters!). Admission is free.
