Grease problems often cause wastewater blockages in homes, businesses and the city pipes. It can also cause an overflow to streets and waterways.

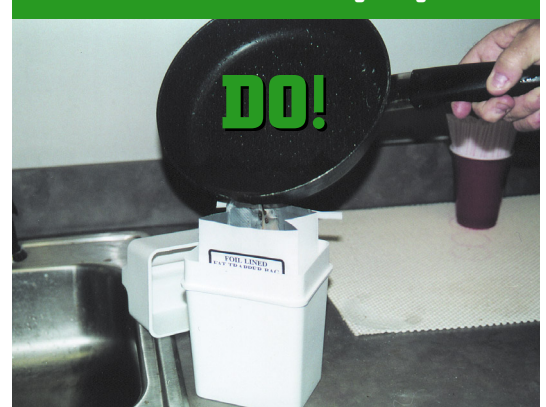
Do your part to help.
