



NOTICE OF WILLINGNESS TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO HAMPTON CITIZENS

Find out about the following projects:

Mercury Boulevard Improvements – Segment II • VDOT Project No. 0258-114-R66, P101, R201, M501 (UPC 104368)

This project will improve pedestrian facilities on both sides of Mercury Boulevard, from Coliseum Drive to North Armistead Avenue by constructing new sidewalk, modifying existing sidewalk to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements, and removing portions of existing right-turn traffic lanes to accommodate the new sidewalk.

Freeman Drive Reconstruction • VDOT Project No. U000-114-R67, P101, R201, M501 (UPC 104372)

This project will realign Freeman Drive to facilitate redevelopment of the adjacent properties to the north, replace the defective pavement along the length of the project, and add pedestrian and bicycle accommodations along the southern side of Freeman Drive. This project will comprise Segment D of the Central Park Trail.

Hampton Roads Center Parkway & Big Bethel Road Improvements • VDOT Project No. U000-114-R03, P101, R201, M501 (UPC 107343)

This project will replace the existing shoulder along approximately 790 feet of westbound Hampton Roads Center Parkway just west of the Big Bethel Road intersection with a 12-foot-wide acceleration lane for vehicles turning right from southbound Big Bethel Road. The work also will include installation of curb and gutter and realignment of the 10-foot-wide shared use path adjacent to the proposed acceleration lane to provide a 7-foot minimum buffer zone behind the back of curb.

Street, Hampton, VA 23669 prior to September 18, 2017. Upon receiving public comments, if it is deemed necessary to hold a public hearing, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
