



## NOTICE OF CITIZEN INFORMATION MEETING TO HAMPTON CITIZENS

**Coliseum Drive Extension – Segment A • VDOT Project No. U000-114-R01, P101, R201, C501, D622 • Federal Project No. STP-5A03(825) (UPC 108731)**

This project will extend Coliseum Drive by approximately 1,650 feet from Hampton Roads Center Parkway to Butler Farm Road. The Coliseum Drive extension will be a four-lane, divided roadway with curb and gutter. Proposed improvements include a wide multi-use path along the east side of the new roadway, a 5-foot sidewalk along the west side of the new roadway, a new intersection at Butler Farm Road, and intersection upgrades at the existing intersection of Coliseum Drive and Hampton Roads Center Parkway. Right-of-way will be acquired for this project. To comply with the National Environmental Policy Act and 23 CFR Part 771, documentation in the form of a Categorical Exclusion (CE) is under preparation. To inform the CE, the City is conducting environmental analyses and coordinating with regulatory agencies to obtain information about environmental and cultural resources in the vicinity of the project.

**Commerce Drive Extension & Convention Drive Pedestrian Improvements • VDOT Project No. U000-114-R75, P101, R201, M501 (UPC 105779)**

This project will extend Commerce Drive by approximately 575 feet from Convention Drive to Mercury Boulevard as well as improving pedestrian facilities along the existing Commerce Drive to Pine Chapel Road and along the existing Convention Drive. This project will extend Commerce Drive by approximately 575 feet from Convention Drive to Mercury Boulevard as well as improving pedestrian facilities along the existing Commerce Drive to Pine Chapel Road and along the existing Convention Drive between Commerce Drive and Coliseum Drive. The Commerce Drive Extension will include on-street parking and lighting. Right-of-way will be acquired for this project.

**North King Street Improvements – Segment IV • VDOT Project No. 0278-114-R00, P101, R201, M501 (UPC 107340)**

This project will include road widening, street resurfacing and restriping, curb and sidewalk renovation, traffic signal upgrades, and street lighting improvements along 750 feet of North King

Street, north of the intersection with Pembroke Avenue, and 200 feet along Pembroke Avenue, east of the intersection with North King Street. Right-of-way will be acquired for this project.

### **Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program Funding Applications**

On October 11, 2017, the City Council of the City of Hampton will consider a proposed resolution requesting funding under the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program for projects enhancing pedestrian and bicycle facilities and amenities at the following locations:

- East Mercury Boulevard between North Mallory Street and Fort Monroe
- Mallory Street between Martin Luther King Blvd and Mercury Blvd
- North Mallory Street between Mercury Boulevard and Pembroke Avenue
- East Mellen Street between North Mallory Street and Fort Monroe

The Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program established by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) in accordance with the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act is intended to help local sponsors fund community based projects that expand non-motorized travel choices and enhance the transportation experience by improving the cultural, historical and environmental aspects of the transportation infrastructure.

**Review** project plans, alignment exhibits, property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative schedules at the meeting. Representatives from the City of Hampton will be available to answer questions. Project information is also available for public review before the meeting until October 4, 2017 at the City of Hampton Public Works Engineering Services Office located on the fourth floor of City Hall at 22 Lincoln Street, Hampton, VA 23669.
