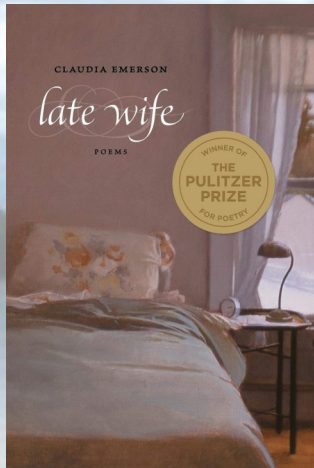

## ***MICRO WORKSHOPS***

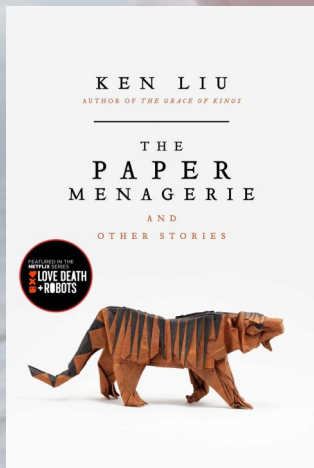
