Expecting fatal and nonfatal shootings to reduce by 50 % and the perception of safety to increase by 85 percent or higher in 5 years.

CITY COUNCIL AWARDS OVER 2.4 MILLION IN GRANTS TO 29 ORGANIZATIONS

In 2021, Hamptons Community Assessment revealed most perceived unsupervised youth, mental health, and drugs as the top three contributors of crime. In response the city funded organizations aiming to offer programs in prevention, intervention, reentry and awareness to address top concerns.

## HAMPTON TO CREATE NEIGHBORHOOD RESOURCE CENTERS

Congressman Bobby Scott awarded Hampton **4.6 million dollars** to create neighborhood offices in five impacted communities to deliver accessible localized wrap-around services. Resources to include community-based prevention, intervention, and access to mental health services.
